

Appliances Care

Designed to be lived in, cared for with intention.



Appliances are integral to the performance and functionality of your home. With correct use, regular maintenance and manufacturer-approved care methods, appliances can operate efficiently and maintain their appearance over time.



Manufacturer Guidance

Always refer to the specific care, cleaning and maintenance instructions provided by the appliance manufacturer before using any product or method.

Where manufacturer guidance differs from general advice, the manufacturer's instructions should take precedence.

Failure to follow manufacturer instructions may void warranties or result in damage to the appliance.





External Finishes

Clean appliance surfaces using a soft cloth and a non-abrasive cleaner suitable for the specific finish (such as stainless steel, glass or enamel)

For stainless steel surfaces, wipe in the direction of the grain where applicable to maintain a consistent finish.

Recommended:

- Non-abrasive cleaners suitable for appliance finishes
- Microfibre cloths
- Mild pH-neutral detergent diluted in warm water

Avoid abrasive pads, harsh chemicals, bleach or solvent-based cleaners, as these may damage coatings, finishes or protective layers.





Internal Maintenance

Clean filters, trays, seals and accessible internal components at intervals recommended by the manufacturer.

Remove debris and residue regularly to maintain hygiene, airflow and appliance efficiency.

Do not dismantle or service internal components unless specified by the manufacturer or carried out by a qualified technician.





Performance & Longevity

Ensure appliances are used within their intended capacity and purpose to avoid unnecessary strain.

Arrange servicing and maintenance where required in accordance with manufacturer recommendations.

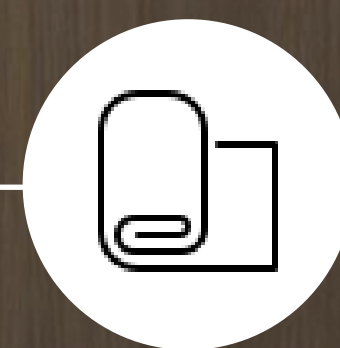
Regular maintenance and correct usage will help extend appliance lifespan and maintain optimal performance.



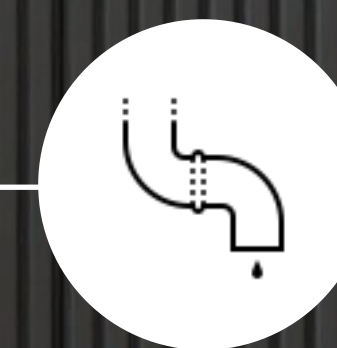
Everyday Care Tips



Always follow manufacturer instructions for operation and cleaning before using any appliance



Wipe external surfaces regularly to prevent build-up of grease, moisture and residue



Avoid using excessive water near electrical components or control panels



Ensure adequate ventilation around appliances to support safe operation and performance



Clean spills immediately to prevent staining, corrosion or damage to surrounding surfaces
