

Bathroom Care

Designed to be lived in, cared for with intention.

Bathrooms are high-use, moisture-rich spaces. With the right products, good ventilation and simple care habits, finishes and fittings will maintain their beauty, performance and longevity over time.



Tiles & Grout

Clean tiles regularly using a pH-neutral cleaner and a soft cloth or mop.

Grout should be cleaned gently and sealed periodically to help prevent staining, moisture absorption and mould growth.

Recommended:

- Mould Off Shower & Grout Cleaner (used sparingly)
- White King Grout & Tile Cleaner
- Mild pH-neutral floor cleaners

Avoid acidic, bleach-heavy or abrasive products, as these can damage grout lines and dull tile finishes over time.





Tapware & Fixtures

Wipe tapware dry after each use to prevent water spots and mineral buildup.

Clean regularly with a soft cloth and a mild, non-abrasive cleaner suitable for chrome, brushed nickel or matte finishes.

Recommended:

- Method Bathroom Cleaner (or equivalent non-abrasive cleaner)
- Mild dishwashing liquid diluted in warm water
- Microfibre cloths

Avoid harsh chemicals, bleach and abrasive pads, which may damage protective coatings and finishes.





Shower & Glass Screens

Rinse and wipe glass surfaces after showering to minimise soap residue and water spots.

For deeper cleaning, use a non-abrasive, glass-safe cleaner with a soft microfibre cloth.

Recommended:

- Windex Crystal Rain (or equivalent glass-safe cleaner)
- Shower Power (use occasionally and as directed)
- Approved non-abrasive glass cleaners suitable for shower screens

Avoid abrasive pads, harsh chemicals or unapproved acidic solutions, as these may damage coatings and reduce glass clarity over time.

Regular light cleaning reduces the need for stronger chemicals and preserves clarity.





Vanity Cabinetry

Clean vanity cabinetry using a lightly damp microfibre cloth and mild detergent.

Dry immediately after cleaning and ensure adequate ventilation to prevent moisture buildup, swelling or mould growth.

Recommended:

- Warm water with mild pH-neutral dishwashing liquid
- Microfibre cloths only

Avoid solvent-based cleaners, abrasive products and excessive water exposure, as these may damage laminated and melamine finishes.



Everyday Care Tips



Wipe tapware and glass
regularly



Use gentle, pH-neutral
cleaning products



Address leaks or moisture
issues promptly



Ensure good ventilation
during and after showers



Avoid leaving standing
water on surfaces
