

General Home Care

Designed to be lived in, cared for with intention.

Maintaining your home through consistent, considered care helps preserve the integrity, appearance and performance of all finishes. Simple, preventative habits can significantly extend the life of your renovation.



Protective Measures

Use mats at entry points and protective pads under furniture to reduce wear, scratching and surface impact.

Lift rather than drag furniture or heavy objects to avoid damaging flooring and joinery. Distribute weight evenly and avoid concentrated load points on delicate surfaces.

Impact, abrasion and excessive load can cause permanent damage to finishes, edges and structural components.





Environmental Considerations

Maintain stable indoor conditions where possible, avoiding excessive humidity, dryness or rapid temperature changes.

Use ventilation, extraction fans and natural airflow to manage moisture in kitchens, bathrooms and laundries.

Balanced indoor environments help preserve materials such as timber, joinery finishes and painted surfaces.





Cleaning Products & Methods

Always select cleaning products that are appropriate for the specific material or finish being cleaned. Use non-abrasive, pH-neutral cleaners wherever possible and follow product instructions carefully.

Incorrect or incompatible cleaning products may cause discolouration, surface damage or deterioration over time.





Performance & Longevity

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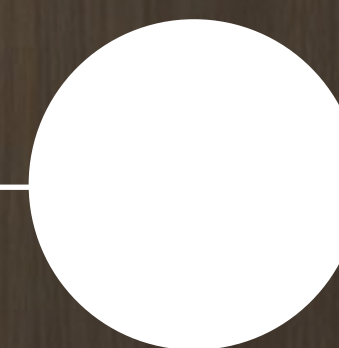
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Everyday Care Tips



Maintain a regular, gentle cleaning routine to prevent build-up of dirt, dust and residue



Address spills, moisture and marks promptly to minimise staining or long-term damage



Ensure adequate ventilation throughout the home to reduce humidity and condensation



Use only soft cloths and non-abrasive, pH-neutral cleaning products suitable for each surface



Avoid using excessive water or harsh chemicals on any internal finishes
