

Joinery & Cabinetry Care

Designed to be lived in, cared for with intention.

Joinery plays a key role in both the function and aesthetic of your home. With consistent, gentle care, cabinetry and custom joinery will maintain their finish, structure and appearance for years to come.



Laminated & Melamine Joinery

Clean surfaces using a soft microfibre cloth lightly dampened with warm water and a mild detergent. Dry immediately after cleaning to prevent moisture absorption and protect edges and finishes.

Recommended:

- Warm water with mild pH-neutral dishwashing liquid
- Microfibre cloths only

Avoid abrasive pads, solvent-based cleaners, bleach and excessive moisture, as these may cause discolouration, swelling or surface damage.





Timber & Veneer Joinery

Dust regularly using a dry or lightly damp microfibre cloth. For deeper cleaning, use products specifically formulated for timber or veneer finishes.

Recommended:

- Osmo Spray Cleaner (or equivalent timber-safe cleaner)
- Gentle timber-safe cleaning products suitable for finished surfaces
- Dry or slightly damp microfibre cloths

Avoid harsh chemicals, excessive moisture and direct heat exposure, as these may dry out, warp or damage timber finishes over time.





Cabinet Interiors & Shelving

Remove contents periodically and wipe internal surfaces using a soft cloth and a mild, pH-neutral detergent

Ensure interiors are fully dry before replacing items, particularly in areas prone to moisture such as kitchens, bathrooms and laundries.

Avoid lining shelves with non-breathable materials that may trap moisture.





Hardware, Hinges & Handles

Wipe handles and hardware regularly using a soft cloth to remove fingerprints and buildup.

For metal finishes, use a non-abrasive cleaner suitable for the specific finish.

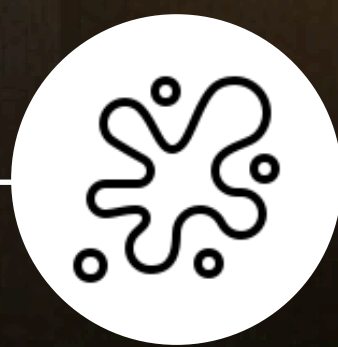
Recommended:

- Microfibre cloth
- Mild dishwashing liquid diluted in warm water

Avoid abrasive cleaners or pads, as these may scratch, dull or degrade protective coatings on metal finishes.



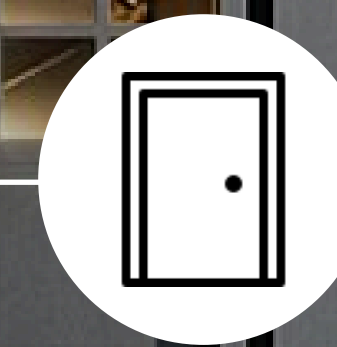
Everyday Care Tips

especially around sink bases



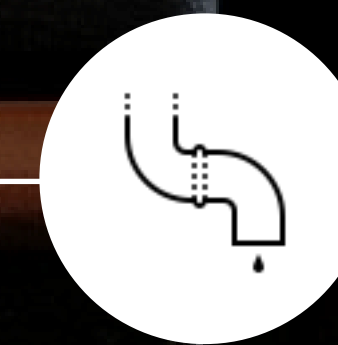
Avoid hanging heavy items on
